Public Works Department: With the eventual arrival of spring, several projects will commence. **The Tyler Street rehabilitation project** from Fox Willow Drive to Valley Road will replace water lines and sewer lines and pave the street with valley pans. The projects for sewer, water, valley pans and paving on B Street, Sublette Street from Hennick to B Street and Bridger Street from Washington to B Street that were started last summer will be finished. The sewer lagoon project is ahead of schedule. It is slated to be completed by summer's end. With the warmer weather, the town crew will be patching potholes and fixing streets.

Thanks to citizens for moving vehicles during the unexpected early spring melt!

Mayor's Office: The **Burzlander Memorial Park** will be dedicated Friday, May 19, 2006 at 10 am in conjunction with **Pinedale's Arbor Day** celebration. The park will be located next to Sled Hill. Thinking about **building this summer**? Check with Meghan Thoreau at Town Hall before you begin construction. Most building plans must go through the Planning and Zoning Board, which meets the first Monday of the month (unless it's a holiday) at 5:30 pm at town hall.

Remember, if you are planning to run for Mayor or Town Council, you must submit a completed application with a \$25 filing fee by 5:00 pm, Monday, April 10, 2006. Elections are Tuesday, May 2, 2006 at Town Hall. Polls will open from 8 am until 7 pm. Pick up applications at Town Hall. The Mayor's term is four years. The Council positions are each for four years.

There will be a Candidates' Forum on Thursday, April 20 at Rendezvous Pointe from 6-8 pm. Meet the candidates and ask them questions!
