17.14.010 Administration. It shall be the responsibility of the town council and its authorized agent, the planning and zoning commission, to administer the zoning ordinances of the town. (Ord. 227, 1993)

17.14.020 Appointment. The planning and zoning commission shall consist of five members, each residing within the corporate limits of the town or within one mile of the corporate limits of the town, who shall be appointed by the mayor with the consent of the town council. Members of the commission shall serve without compensation, other than their expenses.

A. The term of the members of the commission shall be three years, except that the initial term of two members shall be for one year and the term for two members shall be for two years. In the event a vacancy shall occur during the term of any member, a successor shall be appointed by the mayor, with consent of the town council, for the unexpired portion of the term.
